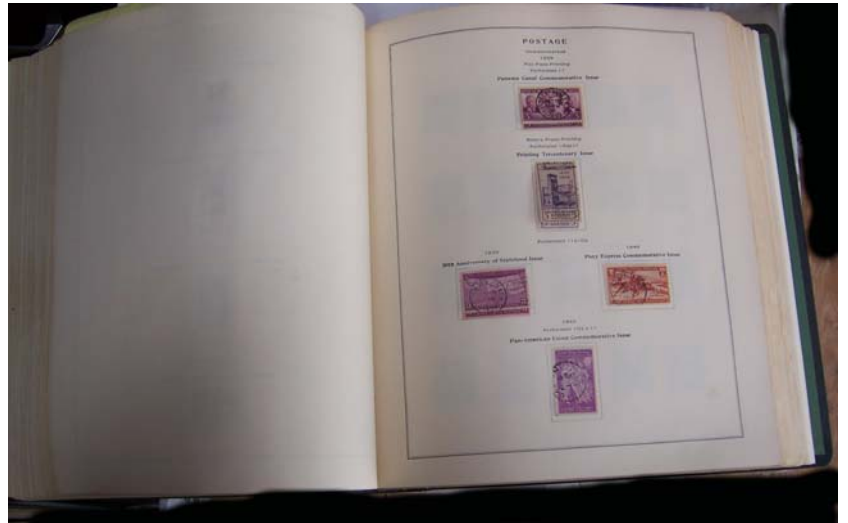

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RMPL LARGE LOTS AUCTION

Saturday, November 14, 2009

Introduction: Many donations received by the Library are difficult to strip down or, alternatively, sell as sole source items. That is because they are too time consuming for our volunteers or because of the absence of a market for specialty materials. Therefore, we began our “bulk lots/large lots” auctions of such donations in 2007. In this way, we ensure that the lots go to appreciative “homes.” The bulk lots consist of cover accumulations, stamp collections, commemorative first day cover collections or national accumulations. Lots are ordered in the list as they were received. This year, we open the auction with a number of specialty collections and materials left to us by the estate of Bob Brown, one of our original charter members and a long time friend of the RMPL.

Date and Time: The auction will be held at the Rocky Mountain Philatelic Library on Saturday, November 14, 2009 beginning at 1:00 pm. We anticipate that it will close by 5:00 pm.

Viewing of Lots: The lots can be viewed at the RMPL the week before Saturday, November 14th.

Format: The auction is a live auction with floor bidders, and mail bids received. Mail bids must arrive at the Library by 4:00 pm on Friday, November 13th, using the bid form found in this booklet. Where practicable, we have attempted to provide the face value of stamps and material in the lots, as well as estimated catalog or retail value of the material contained in the lot. Specialized album pages (such as White Ace, Scott Specialized etc.) are NOT factored into the estimated value, but nonetheless have significant value in and of themselves.

Procedures:

- O The highest bidder takes the lot at one advance over the next highest bid.
- O If a mail bid is the only one for a lot and the mail bid exceeds the minimum bid, the lot shall be sold to the mail bidder at the minimum bid.
- O **Please Note:** Where multiple mail bids are received, the starting floor bid is the 2nd highest of all such mail bids. For example, a lot has a minimum bid of \$50; 6 mail bids are received, the two highest of which are \$75 and \$90. Floor bidding will start, in the example, at \$75.
- O In the case of ties between the highest floor bidder and a mail bidder, one advance over the highest floor bid will be permitted (with preference given to floor bidders).
- O In the case of a tie between mail bidders as the highest bids, preference is accorded the earliest received bid based on the postmark.

Unspecified amount “buy bids” will not be accepted. Because of the large lot/bulk lot nature of the auction, all sales are final with no returns accepted.

Lots failing to draw the minimum bid will be withdrawn for future disposal/auction.

Payment: Successful floor bidders are expected to settle their purchases immediately after the auction at 5:00 pm. All payments (cash, checks: sorry, no credit cards) are to made to the RMPL. Mail bidders are expected to settle their purchases (cash, checks, money orders, sorry, no credit cards) within 2 weeks of the close of the auction.

There are no commissions assessed. However, the successful bidder is assessed a 4.4% sales tax on his/her successful cumulative bids. The sales tax does not apply to out-of-state bidders. Successful mail bidders will be notified of the total cost, including shipping/handling. Shipping is via the USPS. To get an approximate idea of the cost of shipping and handling, calculate postage from zip code 80224.
